



## 2012 Exhibitor Terms and Conditions

Exhibit/partner (hereinafter "exhibitor") booths are open to individuals, businesses and outfitters\* (\*outfitters MUST be members in good standing with a recognized professional hunting organization) and are subject to approval by Inyathi Productions. Inyathi Productions and expo decorator vendor will produce a custom booth for each exhibitor for a fee and will require the necessary graphic art from the exhibitor by September 30, 2011. Inyathi Productions and decorator will set up, dismantle and warehouse the exhibit displays.

Non-Exhibitor solicitation is strictly prohibited.

No exhibitor shall assign, sublet or share the whole or any part of the purchased space. No exhibitor is permitted to show goods or services other than those manufactured or dealt in by him/her in his/her regular course of business and shall be approved by Inyathi Productions pursuant to the exhibitor application.

Collection of applicable state sales tax is the responsibility of the exhibitor making the sale.

There will be no fundraising activities allowed in any booth without explicit approval from the Inyathi Productions Management.

Inyathi Productions Management, venue management or staff members of same will not be responsible for the safety of property of the exhibitors, their agents or employees from theft, damage by fire, accident or other causes. Exhibitors wishing to insure their goods must do so at their own expense.

All decorations must be flame retardant or flame-proof. Exhibits which include the operation of audio visual equipment must be conducted so as to not annoy or disturb adjacent exhibitors or their customers. A video ethics policy will be enforced.

Inyathi Productions reserves the right to restrict exhibitors which because of noise, method of operation, or for any other reason are objectionable in the judgment of the management, and also limit or prohibit any exhibit or evict any exhibitor who, in the opinion of the management, may detract from the general character of the exposition as a whole. In the event of such restrictions or evictions, Inyathi Productions is not liable for any refunds or costs incurred by the exhibitor.

No exhibit shall be allowed to extend beyond the space provided unless authorized by Inyathi Productions.

Exhibitors shall not deface the walls or floors of the building, the booths or the equipment of the booths. If such damage occurs, the exhibitor will be liable.

The exhibitor must comply with all federal, state, county and local fire, police, health or public safety laws, regulations or ordinances, which are, or may be applicable to the exhibit covered by this agreement.

These rules and regulations have been formulated in accordance with public safety rules and in the best interest of the exhibitors, Inyathi Productions, vendors and attendees. Exhibitors expressly accept and agree to abide by these regulations; and any and all matters, whether or not specifically covered in the regulations, are subject to the sole discretions and final decision of Inyathi Productions. Exhibitor agrees to abide by the determinations of Inyathi Productions.

The application for space and the formal notice of assignment by Inyathi Productions and the payment of full fees constitute a contract for the right to use the space allotted. In the event of a fire, strikes, rioting, civil disorders or other circumstances making it impossible, in the sole discretion of Inyathi Productions to operate the exposition with due regard for safety and welfare of exhibitors and attendees, this contract shall terminate and exhibitor hereby waives any claim for damages or compensation there shall be no further liability on the part of either party hereto.

By signing the contract, the exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Inyathi Productions and subcontractors and employees from any and all liability of every nature which may be assessed against them or any of them for any accident, condition, happening or event of any kind whatsoever which may arise from, or may in any way be related to exhibitors attendance at the African Sporting Exposition described herein.

Exhibitors must be set up by 2 PM EST on Thursday, January 26, 2012 and can begin tearing down after the Expo closes at 5:00pm on January 28, 2012. The Expo must be cleared by 10pm on January 28, 2012.

By signing this application, Exhibitor acknowledges that they have read, understands and will abide by the terms and conditions of this agreement. Exhibitor understands a space is reserved only with full payment and delivery of this contract, and is subject of space availability.

Both Inyathi Productions and the Exhibitor agree to use their best efforts to resolve any disagreement arising out of, or under the terms of this agreement through discussion and negotiation to their mutual

satisfaction. Failing a negotiated resolution between the parties, Inyathi Productions and the exhibitor agree to participate in a voluntary mediation (selecting a mediator by mutual agreement of the parties), before pursuing any litigation or resolve their disagreement. This agreement shall be governed by, construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the state of Wyoming and the proper venue for any action brought hereunder or arising here from shall be in Park County, Wyoming. The exhibitor agrees that in no event shall any damages payable by Inyathi Productions exceed the amount of the booth fee actually paid to Inyathi Productions and under no circumstances shall the exhibitor be entitled to receive any consequential, incidental, special or punitive damages. The parties agree that the refund remedy and recourse of the exhibitor hereunder.

This agreement constitutes the entire understanding between Inyathi Productions and the exhibitor with respect to the African Sporting Exposition and the exhibitor's exhibition thereat. This agreement supersedes and replaces any previous documents, correspondence, conversations, and other written or oral understandings related to this agreement, and this agreement may only be amended or supplemented in a writing signed by Inyathi Productions and the exhibitor.
